Interns who join Out Leadership receive immediate opportunities through our extensive engagement with global businesses:

THE POSITION AND THE IDEAL CANDIDATE

Our fellowship program is best suited for recent college graduates, those pursuing graduate studies, or professionals who plan to return to school in the next year. A background (or proven interest) in the for-profit sector is required. A fellowship with Out Leadership is, in general, a 40-hour per week commitment, and we ask that candidates be able to make a commitment to the role for an agreed-upon time period, ideally 9-12 months.

Because Out Leadership is an evolving start-up, our fellowships are dynamic and offer successful candidates the opportunity to interface with clients who are senior business leaders while working in partnership with our smart, fun, growing team.

The ideal candidate will be self-motivated, team-focused, and passionate about advancing LGBT+ equality. An analytical problem solver grounded in quantitative and qualitative methodologies, they will have exceptional communications skills, and the ability to effectively translate ideas into actionable recommendations.

- Skilled at using Microsoft Office and social media platforms
